SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Board is being asked to approve a teaching contract for Richel Dapudong for the 2021-2022 school year (TSAS).

ISSUE:

This will commit KGBSD to approximately \$107,133 (pending verification of service and education).

BACKGROUND:

<u>Richel Dapudong</u> was a previous homeroom fifth-grade teacher for a year in Indonesia. He was also a Special Education Teacher for over twelve years at two different public schools in Thailand. Apart from his extensive teaching and professional experience, he has earned a Ph.D in Educational Management, a Master of Arts in Special Education, Bachelor of Elementary Education, a trained TESOL (Teaching English to speakers of other language), a certified Registered Behaviour Technician (RBT) under the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB), USA. Mr. Dapudong is under a J-1 visa sponsorship program and is expected to arrive in Ketchikan by July. He is working on getting his Type-C teaching/emergency certification here in Alaska.
