Ketchikan High School Principal Position

--Tentative Timeline ---

3/9/22- The position will close at 5:00 PM

3/10/22- Selection of Candidates - A small group will narrow down the applicant pool, focusing on administrative skills/experience.

3/28/22-3/31/22 - Zoom Interviews - A small group will conduct Zoom interviews to narrow the hiring pool down to 2-3 applicants.

4/4/22-4/15/22 - In-person Interviews - The 2-3 candidates will be interviewed in-person. Kayhi staff will have an opportunity to be a part of the interview process after school. Stakeholder interviews will occur in the evening.

Curriculum/PD/Assessment:

- The math committee, comprised of elementary, middle and high school teachers and 2 school board members reviewed math curricula in the fall and winter of this school year. The K-2 group decided they wanted to pilot Illustrative Math, which they did. In the end K-8 grades recommended sticking with Envision Math. The high school math department reviewed textbooks from different vendors, class by class. Most of their recommendations were from Savvas, but 2 are from Houghton Mifflin.
- The breakdown for the 6 year purchase is as follows:
- K-8 Envision \$244,545.40
- High School Savvas textbooks \$89,591.88
- High School Houghton Mifflin textbooks \$11,151
- Total: \$345,288.28
- We will start looking into what professional development will look like for this adoption.
