WHEREAS, from their service in the United States Armed Forces, to their vital role in Alaska's economic future, to their dedication and contributions to artistic and literary endeavors, Alaskan Natives play a key role in Alaska's prosperity; and

WHEREAS, by emphasizing the important background and traditions of Alaskan Native people, the children of the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District can connect with the past and ensure a bright future, so, this month and throughout the year, we celebrate the traditions, languages, and stories of Native Alaskans and ensure their histories and contributions continue to be sustained with each passing generation.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Education of the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District hereby proclaims November 2022 as: Alaskan Native Heritage Month in our District, and encourages all Alaskans to celebrate our Native cultures this month and throughout the year with appropriate respect, educational programs, and activities.
