#### SUMMARY STATEMENT:

#### ISSUE:

We generally bring about 21-24 athletes and 3 Coaches

This year our Trip will be from the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April to the 5<sup>th</sup> of April.

Some of the other benefits of this trip:

Cost: Believe it or not it's cheaper to travel South for an out of Region trip then it is in our own State. In the past Track and Field was the only sport at Kayhi that did not annually have an opportunity to travel out of Region. We are able to bring more athletes and compete in more events then participating in an invitational in Anchorage. We are also able to group house for many of these events- this is unavailable in Anchorage.

Weather: Options in Alaska to host an early season meet due to the weather can be challenging.

These trips are fundraised by our team members and people in the community that support Ketchikan High School activities and Track and Field.

Thank you for taking the time to consider this and giving some of our very best students and athletes a chance to represent Ketchikan outside of the state.
