SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Board is being asked to approve the acceptance of Coronavirus Response & Relief funds to the district totaling \$1,955,491.

#### ISSUE:

Board Policy 3291 states "All grant applications exceeding \$5,000 must be submitted to the School Board prior to their submission to the Grant or agency." Because these additional Coronavirus Relief funds to the district are being provided in the form of a grant, for which the district must submit an application, provide assurances of compliance with federal standards, adhere to regulatory requirements for use, tracking, and reporting, and submit allowable costs for reimbursement, the Board is being asked to approve these funds.

#### BACKGROUND:

The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA), was signed into law on December 27, 2020. The CRRSA Act provides an additional \$54.3 billion for the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II Fund) to support fully reopening K-12 schools, facilitate continuity of learning, and measure and address the learning loss caused by a lack of in-person learning opportunities. The State of Alaska has issued district allocations based on Title I formula funding. These funds are available to apply to expenditures retroactively beginning March 17, 2020, and are available for expenditures through September 30, 2023.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approval of the receipt of Coronavirus Response and Relief funds.
