SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board is being asked to approve the application of the Home Builder's Institute (HBI) Schools to Skills Grant in the amount of \$13,000

ISSUE:

Per Board Policy 3291, School Board approval is required for grant applications exceeding \$5,000.

BACKGROUND:

HBI is dedicated to working with secondary educational institutions to support student access to schools-based instructional programs and skills training in the residential building and construction trades. These important grant funds will support providing valuable training to students through HBI's PACT curriculum with the goal of more students learning about career pathways in residential construction and ultimately resulting in more students entering this industry.

Upon approval, KHS will be granted \$13,000. This is to be used toward HBI PACT licensing as follows: Licensing Cost (\$7,500 Initial Year/\$2,000 Renewal Year), instructor training for 2 instructors (\$1,800), and PACT Student Assessment Fees (\$1,700) for a period not to exceed two years. It is expected that programming will begin at the start of the Fall 2023 Academic Year or as soon as possible upon completion of Instructor Training & Certification.
