CONSENT CALENDAR

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board is being asked to approve change order #1 (CO1) to the 10/16/2024 \$458,000.00 executed contract with Stagecraft Industries, Inc. CO1 has a change in cost from the original award of Sixty-Two Thousand US dollars and no cents (\$62,000.00). This brings the total project amount to \$520,000.00. This work will commence in June 2025.

ISSUE: Board Policy governs the district's purchasing and contracting procedures. Board Policy requires Board approval for expenditures and financial obligations over \$25,000.00.

BACKGROUND:

The Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District (KGBSD) maintenance identified a potential liability concern with the aging rigging on Ketchikan High School auditorium stage. Most of the Ketchikan High School stage rigging components are over 30 years old. They were originally installed in 1993. The old equipment is at the end of its manufacture's 25-to-30-year service life and is in need of replacement. It has become increasingly hard to operate and keep safely balanced. The normal operators of the rigging are user groups and high school stage craft kids not professional stage workers. This significantly increases Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District's liability as the equipment ages.

KGBSD entered a competitive bidding process for this project on August 20, 2024. Stagecraft Industries, Inc. was identified as the sole bidder at the scheduled bid opening at 2pm on September 10, 2024 and subsequently awarded the project. The proposal asked for a price on three components. Contractor's price was Base project to replace rigging (\$434,000.00), additive alternate #1 (AA#1) provide motorized fire curtain winch (\$24,000.00), and additive alternate #2 (AA#2) replace all stage curtains (\$62,000.00). Originally all 3 components bid price exceeded the KGBSD spending authority. Only Base and AA#1 were awarded. Upon review the Ketchikan Gateway Borough expressed their desire to add AA#2 as a change order to the executed contract.

This is a Ketchikan Gateway Borough facilities capital funded and approved project.
