SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board is being asked to approve a contract for \$458,000.00 with Stagecraft Industries Inc. Stagecraft Industries Inc. was the winning proposer through a competitive bidding process that closed at 2pm September 10th, 2024. This is a Ketchikan Gateway Borough funded and approved CIP facilities project.

ISSUE: Board Policy governs the district's purchasing and contracting procedures. Board Policy requires Board approval for expenditures and financial obligations over \$25,000.00.

BACKGROUND:

Ketchikan High School Auditorium still has the original 1993 stage rigging equipment. The old equipment is at the end of its manufacture's 25-to-30-year service life, and it is in need of replacement. It has become increasingly hard to operate and keep safely balanced. The normal operators of the rigging are user groups and high school stage craft kids not professional stage workers. This significantly increases Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District's liability as the equipment ages. KGBSD had a successful RFP competitive bid process. Stagecraft Industries Inc. was the one responsive proposer. Stagecraft Industries originally installed the Kayhi auditorium stage rigging. They have been the go-to stage rigging company for many other Alaska community's auditoriums including Kodiak, Juneau, and Sitka to name a few. We feel confident they will lead us through a successful project. The project is broken into a base and two additive alternates. Base is to replace the rigging, add #1 is installing a motorized fire curtain operator, add#2 was to replace all stage curtains. The amount for the base bid came in at \$434,000.00. Additive alternate #1 was \$24,000.00. Additive alternate #2 was \$62,000.00. KGBSD's MOA with KGB allows a \$500.000.00 budget. We would like to issue a notice of award for base bid plus additive alternate #1 for a total expenditure of \$458,000.00. Alternate #2 can be visited as a future project.
