SUMMARY STATEMENT: The School Board's approval is sought for a trip to South Carolina for the Kayhi softball team in April.

ISSUE:

Per Board Policy 6153, all school-sponsored trips to out-of-state locations require approval of the School Board.

BACKGROUND:

The softball coach plans for her softball team to take this spring softball trip to a Myrtle Beach, South Carolina tournament. The trip allows the team to play competitively before the start of conference games, according to coach.

The trip will involve 14 girls and up to 3 coaches.

Additional information on the rationale for the trip and anticipated costs is attached.

FISCAL NOTE: The travel costs, excluding airfare, are estimated at \$7,030. (*Airfare cannot yet be estimated*). The team plans to fund-raise to cover the expenses for the spring trip.

Reason For Trip? How will this trip benefit the Ketchikan School District?

The annual spring softball tournament trip has been one that Kayhi Softball has tried to continue traditionally over the years. This trip allows the team to play competitive and new competition before the start of conference games. Spring training allows optimal growth as well as continued motivation upon return to improve before playing our Southeast Conference play. Additional Comments:

The seniors planning on trying out for the 2022 softball season are so deserving of this trip. They have not had the option of something like this since their freshman year where many were not ready for this level of play. They have since worked so hard with little opportunity to showcase their growth. The class of 2022 had 0 games or practices their sophomore year as

COVID shut us down before tryouts even took place. In 2021, their junior year, we had maybe 2 full weeks of practice and JV had a total of 3 games where Varsity had only 11. Everyone has faced let down from the pandemic, but what other team or program has faced so much let down and yet stayed tenacious continuing to put in the work not knowing when they will actually be able to just play the game? It is for these reasons that as a coach I want to get my players as many games and wide range experience that this sport can provide for them. In a time of uncertainty, having goals and aspirations it at our highest priority and softball provides that for them. In our program we take pride in being student athletes meaning grades and what we do in the classroom takes highest priority and softball is a privilege we earn. This group coming up from freshman to seniors is a group full of dreams, aspirations, dedication, teamwork and so much more. Putting the spring trip on the table is another reason for them to get excited about all the hard work they are putting in. We are starting to see athletes look at continuing their game into the college level once again which is very exciting. It is trips like this that can help open their eyes to what could be if they continue to work hard and earn it.

Should this trip be approved we have extra fundraising measures we will put in place to ensure it is covered and goes smoothly. Myrtle Beach South Carolina Spring Softball Trip

Tournament Dates: 4/4-8

Would need to arrive by 4/3 and leave – back home 4/9

Up to 3 coaches total (2 rooms)

Up to 14 girls total (2 rooms, 3 bedroom condos)

Place of stay: Avista Resort Ocean Boulevard, North Myrtle Beach SC

Estimated room cost: \$3,600.00

2 adult rooms for 6 nights - per room ~\$800.00 - \$1,600.00

3 rooms for the kids – 3 bedroom condos ~\$1,000.00 each - \$2,000.00

Will need to overnight in Seattle 4/2 estimated hotel cost ~\$650.00

*To hold a slot for this tournament there must be a \$500 non-refundable deposit submitted with the application that I have attached for review

This hotel will have discounted rates at a closer date for those attending the tournament event as they have partnered. These rooms also come with kitchens which will allow us to stay in more and save cost on group meals.

The tournament itself includes one game a day plus allotted field practice and training time.

Airfare: I do not have access to estimate this

*Due to the lengthy travel, we would also need to overnight in Seattle on 4/2 and continue flying to SC the morning of 4/3, this would add an additional cost for rooms that night unless a redeye option becomes available

Transportation: enterprise was recommended by the tournament director, right now would be roughly \$1140 per minivan - \$2,280.00 hopefully bigger vans are available by then
