SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Board is being asked to approve a teaching contract for Margaret Gore as Special Education teacher for the 2021-2022 school year (FME).

ISSUE:

This will commit KGBSD to approximately **\$81,528.95** (pending verification of service and education).

BACKGROUND:

Ms. Margaret Gore was a general and special education teacher at Southeast Island School District for two years. She has also taught life skills special education for a year before moving into a regular elementary classroom at Kennewick, Washington. Ms. Gore has a bachelor degree in education from Western Governors University and she holds a valid Alaska teaching certification with an endorsement for Special Education.
