SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board is being asked to approve purchase and associated travel costs for CPI training of one District staff at each building.

ISSUE: Per Board Policy 3300, School Board approval is required for purchases and/or expenditures over \$25,000.

BACKGROUND: The District utilizes the Crisis Prevention Institute's Nonviolent Crisis Intervention training model for use with target student populations. CPI's NCI training is recommended by DEED, and is an evidence-based and fully accredited training program for use in school districts. Historically, the responsibility for training staff fell to one or two individuals in the District, and the upkeep of training and knowledge on appropriate nonviolent interventions and defensive strategies in scenarios where violence may take place was difficult to maintain districtwide. As a solution, the Special Education Department is proposing to implement a new model for providing staff CPI's non-violent crisis intervention (NCI) training. The new model will establish a CPI trainer/staff member at every building (primarily administrators) to carry out those duties. This change constitutes a larger investment financially, but provides increased support and more robust, in-house consultation for crisis prevention, intervention, and follow up.

RECOMMENDATION: Approval of the purchase and associated travel for CPI trainer training of District staff.

*Training costs include a 2-day blended instruction of 5 trainers at \$3,909 each, 2 virtual certification renewals at \$1,409 each, and travel costs for 5 people totaling approximately \$4,086
