SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board Policy Committee is proposing approval of revisions to BP 1400 Relations between other Governmental Agencies and the schools.

ISSUE/BACKGROUND:

Board Bylaw 9300 states that "The formulation and adoption of written Board policies shall constitute the basic method by which the Board shall govern the school district." Board Policy 0500 and Board Bylaw 9311 both address the ongoing review of district policies and programs by the School Board. The proposed revisions are in line with AASB suggested policy updates.

RELATIONS BETWEEN OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND THE SCHOOLS

BP 1400

The School Board recognizes that agencies at all levels of government share its concern and responsibility for the welfare, health and safety of our youth. The Board further recognizes that tribal governments are committed to meeting the needs of tribal students within the district. The School Board and staff shall take every opportunity to work cooperatively with these agencies for the benefit of our students.

The Superintendent or their designee shall initiate and maintain good-working cooperative relationships with representatives of other public agencies, tribal governments, or tribal government educational programs in order to help our schools and students make use of the resources which governmental agencies can provide. The Superintendent or their designee shall ensure that agreements with other agencies which involve the exchange of funds or reciprocal services are executed in writing so that roles and responsibilities are clearly defined. The District shall make information available to parents/guardians about shared or cooperative services so that students may benefit to the fullest extent. Agreements may be shared among agencies to prevent duplicative efforts and to expedite cooperative programs and services.
