SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Board is being asked to approve a teaching contract for Daniel Patton for the 2021-2022 school year (KHS).

ISSUE:

This will commit KGBSD to approximately \$109,804 (pending verification of service and education).

BACKGROUND:

Daniel Patton was a previous Science/Spanish/Japanese teacher at Schoenbar Middle School for two school years. He moved to Switzerland to teach for an international school in the subject areas of Science, ESL and STEAM. Before he worked in the district, he was also an ESL teacher for an elementary and middle school in Japan for a year. Mr. Patton has a BA degree in Biological Science from the University of Alaska, Fairbanks, a MA degree in Teaching Secondary Science from the University of Alaska Southeast, Juneau and another MA degree in International Education Administration from Endicott College, Massachusetts.
