### SUMMARY STATEMENT:

At their regularly scheduled meeting on January 29<sup>th</sup>, the Board of Education tasked the Administration with researching the closure of Point Higgens Elementary School in accordance with Board Policy 0530, as well as creating budgets based upon the current BSA of \$5,960 and no additional funding from the State of Alaska. The Administration also reviewed additional recommendations from the Board of Education and provided cost estimates each scenario could generate.

### **ISSUE/BACKGROUND:**

Board Policy 0530 states that <u>"The Board strives to maintain schools in local communities but recognizes that low student</u> <u>enrollment or other factors may necessitate temporary or permanent closure of a school.</u>" Administration has identified that, given the tenuous nature of funding from the State of Alaska and continued enrollment decline, available resources dictate that in order to maintain, to the best of its ability, its current programmatic offerings, Administration proposes that KGBSD begin the process of creating a Point Higgins Elementary School closure plan for the closure of Point Higgins Elementary School beginning with the FY2025-2026 School Year.

While the closure of Point Higgins Elementary School will generate significant fiscal savings, additional budgetary cuts are required to close the deficit gap created by funding at the \$5,960 BSA and no additional State funding. District Office and Building Administrators crafted two different scenarios to eliminate the nearly \$6,000,000 funding shortfall from a \$5,960 BSA and no additional State funding. One scenario included the closure of Point Higgins Elementary School, the second scenario did not include the closure.

Additionally, the following scenarios were also reviewed:

- House Middle School and High School at K-Hi. -
- Rethink how elementary can be restructured in the remaining schools: K-6 Pt Higgins K-3 FME 4-6
- Cap incoming teacher seniority i.e., 10 to 15 years' experience max
- Move central admin to a school site.
- Split Grade Levels at all K-6 Schools
