SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Social Studies Curriculum Review Committee met on January 19th, 2024, and requested the proposed revisions to BP 6146.10 High School Graduation requirements. Committee members completed their review work April 4th, 2024.

ISSUE/BACKGROUND:

Board Bylaw 9300 states that "The formulation and adoption of written Board policies shall constitute the basic method by which the Board shall govern the school district." Board Policy 0500 and Board Bylaw 9311 both address the ongoing review of district policies and programs by the School Board. The proposed revisions are in line with AASB suggested policy updates.

High School Graduation Requirements BP 6146.1

The Superintendent or designee shall prepare for Board approval a plan consisting of district graduation requirements. Students shall receive diplomas of graduation from high school only after meeting the following district graduation requirements.

Graduation Requirements - Effective Date, Graduating Class of 2021 2026

Graduation course requirements for a high school diploma are as follows:

English-Language Arts 4 credits

Social Studies * 3 credits

Math 3 credits

Science 3 credits

Health .5 credits

Physical Education .5 credits

Electives 7 credits

Career Technical Education 1 credit

and/or Fine Arts

TOTAL CREDITS REQUIRED FOR

GRADUATION

22 credits

Additional requirements include 100 hours or work experience or community service and completion of the State of Alaska Job Application.

^{*} Note: The three units of credit in social studies must include one-half unit of credit in Alaska history or demonstration that the student meets the Alaska history performance

standards. This requirement will not apply to a student who (1) transfers into high school after the student's second year of high school; or (2) has already successfully completed a high school state history course in another state, 4 AAC -6.075. The three units in social studies must also include one unit of credit of American Government U.S. History and one-half unit of credit in American Government/Civics.

Students in the Class of 2026 may apply to the Superintendent or Superintentendent's Designee to waive the US History requirement due to extenuating circumstances, with the Superintendent or Designee making a determination based on the student's unique circumstances and academic goals. If such a waiver is granted, a student must still fulfill the requirement of 3 credits of social studies and other required coursework.
