The Board is being asked to approve a teaching contract for Rebekah Beckett for the 2021-2022 school year (KCS).

ISSUE:

This will commit KGBSD to approximately \$81,833 (pending verification of service and education).

BACKGROUND:

Rebekah Beckett is currently working at Ketchikan Charter School as a paraprofessional. She has also worked as a long term substitute teacher for the district while enrolled in her Master's degree program. Ms. Beckett has a BA degree in Communication Studies from Central Washington University and is completing her Master's degree in Education at the University of Alaska Southeast.
