SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The School Board's approval is sought for the Ketchikan High School softball team to travel to Orlando, Florida for KSA Events Softball Spring Training in March of 2023.

ISSUE:

Per Board Policy 6153, all school-sponsored trips to out-of-state locations require approval of the School Board.

BACKGROUND:

Every year our goal is to start out our season on a field as early as possible. Unfortunately, our weather limits us on when that time gets to take place. So, for years now we have been traveling south to get some good quality softball reps under our belt before going into our conference games. It is important to put everything we have worked on and focused on in the off and preseason, onto an actual softball field before playing higher pressure games.
