#### Governor's Budget

- \$175 million (\$680) in one-time outside the formula funding for education
- \$7.3 million one-time funds for Pupil Transportation
- \$21 Million for BAG Grants (11.18 Million was vetoed)
- \$600,000 for Coding in Minecraft
- \$750,000 for CTE Initiatives
- \$500,000 for Hunter Education
- \$1,655 PFD per recipient

#### Vetoes:

- \$5.2 million to support the Alaska Reads Act. (\$180 to each K-3 student and an additional \$100 for students in Title I schools, not to exceed \$5.2 million)
  - Statement of objection from the Governor: Preserve general funds for savings and fiscal stability. One-time \$680 Base Student Allocation (BSA) increase. Additional funding support provided to districts under.
- \$11.9 million to comply with the federal maintenance of equity requirement for FY22, to help bring Alaska into compliance with USED
- \$500,000 for Mt. Edgecumbe student travel during winter break
