The Board is being asked to approve a teaching contract for Matthew Lenhard for the 2021-2022 school year (KHS).

ISSUE:

This will commit KGBSD to approximately **\$114,370.78** (pending verification of service and education).

Mr. Lenhard is being hired as Band Director at Ketchikan High School.

BACKGROUND:

Matthew Lenhard was a Music Director at Petersburg School District for almost twenty-three years. He also worked as a music teacher for both private and public schools in Washington for almost four years. Mr. Lenhard has earned his BA degree in Music Education from Seattle Pacific University. He has a valid Alaska teaching certification.
