PRIDE MONTH

WHEREAS, the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District recognizes the work of local advocates and organizations like Ketchikan Pride Alliance, Ketchikan Queer Collective, Ketchikan Youth Alliance, Ketchikan Youth for Change, WISH, Kayhi GSA and The Wellness Coalition; and

WHEREAS, The Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District recognizes disparities between LGBTQ and Non-LGBTQ People in the realms of health, employment, the justice system, and law enforcement interactions, education, housing, and immigration, and;

WHEREAS, the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District is committed to strengthening anti discrimination protections for all KGBSD students and staff, and recognizes the resilience and determination of many individuals who are fighting to live freely and authentically.

NOW THEREFORE, the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District joins with the City of Ketchikan in proclaiming June 2025 PRIDE MONTH and affirms our obligation to uphold the dignity of all people, and to dedicate ourselves to protecting the most vulnerable among us.
