**WHEREAS**, Jason Lorig will be a senior at Ketchikan High School and a leader amongst the Ketchikan High School Boys Track and Field team; and

**WHEREAS**, Prior to this track season Lorig finished first in ASAA/First National Bank Alaska Track and Field 100-meter Championship in 2023 with a time of 11.26 seconds; and

**WHEREAS**, Lorig placed first in the 2024 ASAA/First National Bank Alaska Track and Field 100-meter Championship, with a winning time of 11.06 seconds, beating his closest competitor by two-tenths of a second; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, Lorig also set a new Ketchikan High School record of 20 feet 10 inches in the long jump event; and

**WHEREAS**, Lorig currently holds four Kayhi School records in the 200-meter dash, the 4x100 meter relay, and the Long Jump, all earned at the 2024 State Championships; and

**WHEREAS**, he is currently the top athlete in his age group in the 60 meter dash in the entire Pacific Northwest; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District, wishes to formally recognize Jason Lorig for his successful 2024 track and field season, his dedication to those events, his decisive win in the 100-meter race as State Champion; and hereby convey this very special recognition by way of this proclamation.
